## CORDOBA

### New high grade Cu-Au discoveries within a large holding

Cordoba's project, currently the San Matias and El Alacrán properties, in Colombia comprises a 200km<sup>2</sup> land package that contains several known areas of Cu-Au mineralization in replacement-type, veins, and porphyry stockwork.

The project is located at low elevation and in a region with excellent infrastructure and existing large nickel and coal mines.

The Cordoba project lies on the newly recognised northern extension of the richly endowed Mid Cauca Belt. The nature of mineralization and related alteration within the Project is similar to those of other large high-grade Cu-Au porphyry and associated replacement deposits.

Between San Matias and El Alacrán, there have been some excellent intersections including an intersection at Montiel on the San Matias claims of **101.1m @ 1.0% Cu and 0.65 g/t Au** and an intersection from El Alacrán of **139m of 1.23% Cu and 0.74 g/t Au**.



A: Montiel East: large hand-excavated pit exposes strong quartz-bornite-chalcopyrite-magnetite porphyry stockwork. Channel sample along pit wall returned: **154m @ 2.6 g/t Au & 1.6% Cu**.



B: Montiel West: Intense porphyry quartz stockwork exposed by hydraulic washing of laterite soils for gold. Undrilled and open in all directions.



C+D: Mapping has defined an 800m diameter quartz-bornite-chalcopyrite stockwork zone exposed at Costa Azul, 2 km south of Montiel East and West. Recent trenching: **75m @ 1.0 g/t Au and 0.3% Cu**.
